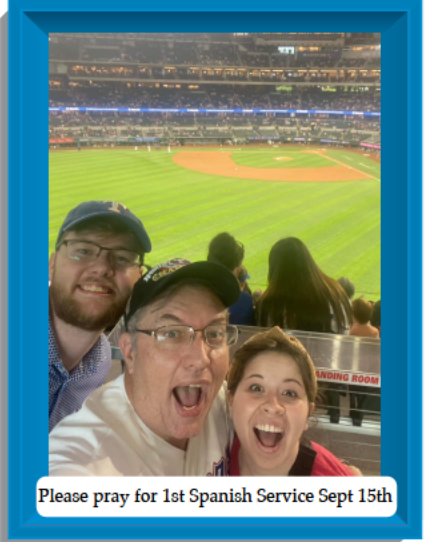
FAMILY HAPPENINGS
