



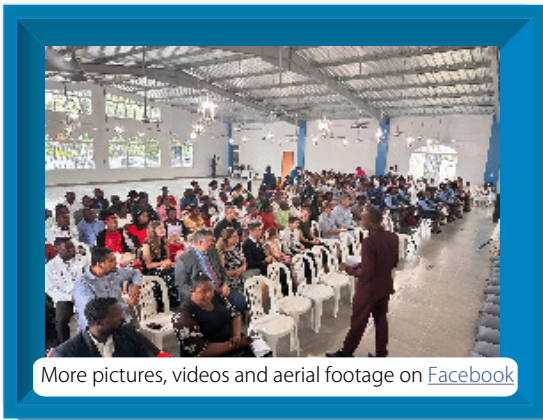

Our family was tired (exhausted actually), but it was the good kind of tired. Our old missionary friend, Alberto Castilla, from the Bible Baptist Church in Guanabacoa, Cuba, flew in and invited our family to be a part of their 20th anniversary services next month. It is hard to believe it has been that long since we started the churches in Cuba. We presented Jose Antonio's family, missionaries to Haiti, to the church and presented them with a check for one year's worth of support to emphasize the importance missions has played in the life of the church. Wesley also taught on what an invitation consists of and the importance of making the church a house of prayer.
